

Bridger Valley Electric Announces Board Election

The Bridger Valley Electric Board has set the date and time of the 2021 Annual Meeting of the members. Based on current guidelines we will have a normal (in person) meeting this year. It will be in the Lyman High School on April 24th beginning at 10:00 AM. The meeting will also be available virtually for those who wish to attend electronically.

At this year's meeting two director seats are up for election. One seat is in District 3, Ft. Bridger, Milburne, Carter, Piedmont, and the Bear River area (excluding Uinta Lands and Manor Lands). The other seat is District 2, the Lyman area. These two board seats are currently held by Ruth Rees (District 3) and Jason Haycock (District 2). If anyone is interested in running for these positions, they should contact Bridger Valley Electric as soon as possible.

Directors must live in the district they wish to represent. They must be of high integrity and be willing to do their due diligence as a director to make sure the Co-op stays financially sound. They must also be available for training to learn about the business of electric cooperatives. Some positions on the board require representing Bridger Valley Electric on other boards such as Deseret Power, Wyoming Rural Electric Association and Utah Rural Electric Cooperative Association. The BVEA board typically meets the second Tuesday of each month for most of the day.

Interested parties may run for the positions by having 15 bona fide members of their district sign a petition. The petition must be presented to Bridger Valley Electric by Friday, March 12, 2020 at 4 p.m. You are encouraged to return your petition before that date however so that you may have information published about your candidacy in the April WREN Magazine and the Annual Meeting booklet. Printing deadlines require the petition and information be returned by March 5th.
