

Wyoming law provides Wyoming residents with rights to access and delete certain “Personal Data” we collect about them, as well as to restrict the use of that Personal Data for targeted advertising, restrict the “sale” of that Personal Data, and control our use of Personal Data considered sensitive. If you are a Wyoming resident, you also have a right not to receive discriminatory treatment for the exercise of your privacy rights.

The Wyoming Consumer Privacy Act defines “Personal Data” to mean “information that is linked or reasonably linkable to an identified or identifiable individual.” When we use the term “personal information” in our Privacy Policy, it includes Personal Data covered by this definition.
